



# Earn College Credit at Cabrini



**Students have a few options to earn their college credit while they go to school here, at CHS:**

- 🦁 One way is to take the **Advanced Placement courses** and their subsequent tests designed by AP College Board. Students are able to earn credit based on the test scores that they received.
- 🦁 Another way to earn college credit is through **Dual Enrollment**, a program that allows students to take college courses for **FREE**. (For more information, please see the student handbook online.)
  - ◆ Students are able to dual enroll in either a large public university, a small private college, or a community college, depending on what is the best fit for them and their future plans.
  - ◆ The students will need to be accepted to the dual enrollment program based on transcripts and test scores (ACT, PSAT, ASPIRE), and will be placed in to appropriate level courses based on that information.
  - ◆ CHS students who have taken advantage of this opportunity can enroll in anything from aviation to psychology.

Our students are motivated to plan for their futures, and once they make a decision about what they want to study, they can begin the preparation for starting their college education here at CHS. These programs allow our students to have real experiences with college level rigor, and better prepare them for the transition into college.
