

Homecoming Dance Dress Code

We would like to remind everyone that Homecoming is considered to be a semi-formal dance. Therefore, the following dress code guidelines apply for all Cabrini students and their guests.

- Ladies are expected to wear semi-formal dresses that are modest, tasteful, and appropriate for a Catholic school.
 - Skirts should be no shorter than 3" above the middle of the knee.
 - No plunging necklines or skin-tight dresses
 - Dresses may be backless as long as they are not cut below the waist line
 - No midriff-bearing cutouts
 - Slits cannot go above the knee
- In addition, white dresses should be avoided, as it is a special tradition for the Homecoming Court to wear white.

- Gentlemen are expected to wear at minimum dress pants with a button-up dress shirt and tie. Gentlemen are not to remove their shirt at any time.

- All CHS rules regarding proper attire are to be followed regarding piercings, tattoos, etc.
- If you plan to remove your formal footwear, you must bring additional footwear as bare feet are not permitted.
- All CHS dance policies and procedures will apply. Please see pages 55-56 in your student handbook to review.
- We have the right to refuse admittance or require persons not properly attired to leave.
