

## **International Student Application Procedure**

### **Step 1.**

A family or guardian must apply for admission in writing to a Catholic school and be accepted according to that school's Admissions Policies, as well as the Archdiocese of Detroit's Policies.

Along with initial admission criteria, the school will also review the following: English language proficiency, valid academic transcripts (must be translated in to English), and financial stability (i.e. bank statements, pay stubs, checks, etc.).

*Please note: It is the family or guardian's responsibility to provide all the proper documentation for the school to review.*

### **ALL APPLICATION MATERIALS ARE DUE BY APRIL 20, 2017**

### **Step 2.**

Once the student has demonstrated English proficiency through an interview, either in person or via Skype, passed a language test, as well as provided academic transcripts and a clean disciplinary record, Cabrini will provide a letter of acceptance.

### **Step 3.**

Upon acceptance, Cabrini High School will request an I-20 form from the Archdiocese of Detroit's Office of Immigration. The potential student will then be entered in the SEVIS immigration database. This form will be needed for the student's U.S.

Consulate/Embassy visa appointment.

*Please note: Before going to the U.S. Embassy, the student/family must pay a government fee, called the SEVIS I-901 fee. It may be paid online at [www.fmjfee.gov](http://www.fmjfee.gov).*

Before the I-20 form is delivered to the student/family, a tuition contract must be signed and on file at Cabrini High School.
